. . . I'm using Visual Studio Enterprise 2015. I've created a new Git repository on my local disk. I've checked out the git repository into my local disk. I've added a remote Git repository named (Azure-Source). I've set the Azure remote repo to be read-only. I've set the Repository Path property to the path to my local disk I've committed. I've pushed. I've received an error: error: Cannot access the repository that you specified via HTTP. I get the error no matter what I try. I've tried: Cloning to a new directory. Cloning to an existing directory. Using the path and HTTP URI of my Git repo hosted on my local disk. Using the path and HTTP URI of my Git repo hosted on another machine on my local network. I've tried to delete the Git repository on my local disk, but I'm not able to. It will not delete when I run the Delete button on Git Status. It appears in both the Source Control Explorer and the Repository Explorer. I'm unable to delete it. The properties seem to indicate that I can delete it, but I can't. A: Well after two days of hair pulling and swearing, I finally figured out what was wrong. I had set the Authentication method for the repository on my Visual Studio Online account to "Basic". This is obviously not what I want. I do not want my account to be tied to one user name and password. What I want is a Git repository that can be accessed by any of my users. I was able to delete the Git repository, and create a new one in its place. When I tried to push the new Git repository, I received the same error I had earlier. I tried to delete the new repository, but I was still unable to. When I navigated to the properties of the Git repository on Visual Studio Online, I was presented with the following options: Author Name Committer Name Identity Repository URI Repository Path Template Path I filled in the Author name. I checked the box for the Identity, clicked OK, and deleted the git repository. I was able to create a new Git repository on my local disk, and push it to Azure. I tried the same thing on my colleagues' computers. We all have Visual Studio Enterprise 2015. We are able to create a new Git repository on local disk and push it to Azure. So, this may not be the solution for everyone, but for me, it was.
